Feb 29 - Fly from Jakarta to Dhaka, Bangladesh

Mar 1-4 - Youth Camp for Muslim/Hindu youth

Mar 5-7 - Conference for AIM Partner indigenous pastoral/missionary staff

It is always a joy to hear about the way in which God is working through our partners in Asia. Kirit Debbarma in India, with whom we have worked significantly, recently reported that two new fellowships were planted in December. Praise God for the advance of the Gospel among the unreached. In May, Kirit will be coming to connect with believers here in Manitoba. We hope that a number of you can meet with him during his time here.

1. Pray for Lorilee and the kids while I am away in Asia. Pray especially for strength during this final trimester of pregnancy (baby is due in mid April). As usual, pray also for wisdom and patience.
2. Pray for fruitful ministry among the pastors. Pray as I will have opportunities to share among those who do not yet know Christ, particularly at the youth camp.
3. Praise God for church growth in Indonesia; pray also for discipleship of these new believers. Pray for courage for the church in Bangladesh as threats increase from radicals.
